1. Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of appropriate order or direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7.

2. On 31.07.2025, following order was passed:

*“ Both the petitioners herein are married but without impleading their earlier spouse as party to the petition, the instant protection petition has been filed before this Court.
Adjourned to 12.08.2025 to enable the petitioners to implead them as party to the present petition.”*

3. Today, at the very outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that he has instructions to withdraw the present petition and therefore prays for its withdrawal.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for.
