1. In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to rejoin his duty as Beldar, as has been done in the case of a similarly situated employee, namely, Dalvider. Further prayer has been made for directing the respondents to remit the subsistence allowance @ 75% alongwith interest, as per Haryana Civil Services (General) Rules.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, the petitioner shall be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to the representation dated 13.06.2025 (Annexure P-3), in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Piyush Khanna, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1. Mr. Vikrant Pamboo,

Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3. They do not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 13.06.2025 (Annexure P-3), if received by its office, within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
6. Needless to say that the representation shall be decided after giving due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and by passing a detailed and reasoned speaking order.
7. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
