1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from Respondents No. 5 to 7.

2. It appears that the dispute between the petitioners and respondents No. 5 to 7 is monetary in nature. In view of the nature of the dispute, this Court is of the opinion that the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is not maintainable, as no writ lies for the enforcement of private monetary claims. Furthermore, the petitioners have an alternative and efficacious remedy available under the law. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
