The prayer in the present petition under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 is for the grant of interim bail for a period of four weeks in case FIR No.29 dated 13.03.2025 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 21-B, 25, 27-A, 29 (61, 85) of NDPS Act (Section 21-C of NDPS Act added later on) at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the wife of the petitioner has delivered a child on 12.09.2025. He, therefore prays that the petitioner be granted the concession of interim regular bail.

The learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Looking at the antecedents of the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to grant interim bail to the petitioner. However, in view of the fact that the wife of the petitioner has delivered a child on 12.09.2025, the Jail Superintendent concerned is directed to send the

petitioner-Sikander Singh alias Khandu in police custody to his residence at Village Gaggobua, Tarn Taran, Punjab from 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m on 25.09.2025, 26.09.2025 and 27.09.2025. The expenses incurred for the aforesaid purpose shall be borne by the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of.
