issuance of direction to respondent No. 1 (District Revenue Officer-cum-
Land Acquisition Collector, Jhajjar) for taking a final call on the petition
(Annexure P-6) filed at the instance of petitioners having invoked Section
28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894.

[3] Upon advance notice, Ms. Komal Sharma, Deputy Advocate
General, Haryana, appears on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 & 2 and on
instructions submits that the aforementioned petition (Annexure P-6) shall
be decided finally within two months from today after affording opportunity

of hearing to the petitioners.

[4] In view of the aforesaid assurance / undertaking, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed off** accordingly.

[5] The respondent-State of Haryana shall be bound by its stand as taken.

[6] It is made clear that the above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion upon the maintainability or merits of the petition filed at the instance of petitioners.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, the same shall also stand disposed off.
