1. Present petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0108 dated 17.06.2025 under Sections 108, 3(5) of BNS, registered at Police Station Mataur, District District SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab.
2. Vide order dated 04.08.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 04.08.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.
