1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to decide the review application dated 14.08.2024 filed by the petitioner at the earliest by affording adequate opportunity of hearing to him.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that with regard to the grievance, the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 21.05.2025 (Annexure P-9) but no action has been taken thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2-The General Manager, Indian Bank, Review Authority HRM Department, is directed to consider and decide the said review application, in a time bound manner in accordance with law.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Gaurav Goel, Advocate and Mr. Teginder Singh, Advocate, enter appearance and accept notice on behalf of the respondent-Bank and



submit that the said review application dated 14.08.2024 shall be decided by the respondents within a period of 04 months.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the instant writ petition.

6. In view of the above, the instant writ petition is disposed of as not pressed. The respondents shall however remain bound by the aforesaid statement made by the counsel and decide the pending review application within the time frame as undertaken today in the Court.
