1. Present petition has been for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents No.4 to 9 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that both the petitioners are major and are living in live-in-relationship and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from the private respondents. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 29.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2.
3. Notice of motion to respondents no.1 to 3-State only.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.
5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No.-2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Panchkula to

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decide the representation dated 29.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of their live-in relationship.
