MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (Oral)

1. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the entire cheque amount already stands paid to the respondent-complainant by way of 2 demand drafts.

2. Counsel appearing for respondent-complainant has not disputed the submission made by Learned Counsel for the applicant-petitioner qua the entire cheque amount in the sum of Rs.7 lakhs having been received by the respondent-complainant from the petitioner.

3. Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that in view of the findings of fact recorded by the Court below, he would not press the instant petition on merits and instead restrict his submissions to the period already undergone by the petitioner, which prayer has not been opposed by counsel for the respondent-complainant as well.

4. Keeping in view the above, it is ordered that the substantive sentence of 6 months be reduced to the period already undergone by the petitioner i.e. 2 months 22 days.

5. With the above-said modification, the present revision petition stands disposed of.
