Prayer in this petition is for directing the respondents for granting the benefit of technical pay scales to the petitioner in view of the *judgment dated 25.03.2025* passed by a Division Bench of this Court in a bunch of writ petitions including *CWP No.11710-2014* titled as '*Sarbans Singh and Others Versus State of Haryana and Others*'.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the issue involved in the present case is covered by the *judgment dated 25.03.2025* passed in *CWP No.11710-2014* titled as '*Sarbans Singh and Others Versus State of Haryana and Others*' (*supra*). He further submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-8) and that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case the respondent No.2 – The Director General, Transport Department, Haryana Roadways, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated

27.05.2025 (Annexure P-8) in light of the ***judgment dated 25.03.2025*** passed in ***CWP No.11710-2014*** titled as '***Sarbans Singh and Others Versus State of Haryana and Others***' (*supra*).

Notice of motion.

Dr. (Ms.) Malvika Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice and submits that she has no objection to the abovesaid prayer being accepted.

The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-8) served by the petitioner and to take a considerate decision thereupon in light of the ***judgment dated 25.03.2025*** passed in ***CWP No.11710-2014*** titled as '***Sarbans Singh and Others Versus State of Haryana and Others***' (*supra*) within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that in the event of the petitioner being found eligible for the benefits as claimed in the light of the ***judgment dated 25.03.2025*** passed in ***CWP No.11710-2014*** titled as '***Sarbans Singh and Others Versus State of Haryana and Others***' (*supra*), the necessary benefits shall also be released to him within a further period of two months.
