1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is seeking directions to respondent No.2 to decide his representation dated 14.07.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 i.e. The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide or take necessary action on the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner raising his grievances which has not been considered and no action has been taken till now.

4. Mr. Ravinder Singh, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 14.07.2025 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today in accordance with law.
