Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS with the allegations that she had lodged one FIR No. 55 dated 19.08.2019, under Section 384 of IPC and Section 7, 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, against police officials and thereafter, two false cases under NDPS Act, have been registered against her, in which she has been released on anticipatory bail. Now grievance of the petitioner is that she is being pressurized to enter into a compromise with the accused involved in the case under the Prevention of Corruption Act.
2. By way of present petition, petitioner has sought directions to the effect that respondent No.2 be directed to initiate action against respondents No. 3 to 5 and respondent No. 2 should be directed to ensure that she will not be falsely implicated in any other case. However, the prayer that no case should be registered, is not tenable and no such direction can be issued. Copy of the petition be sent to respondent No.2 to treat it as a representation and decide the same qua prayer clause (i) of the same.
