SURYA PARTAP SINGH. J.(Oral)

1. This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNSS'), for anticipatory bail, in a case arising out of FIR No.34 dated 30.01.2025 under Section 420 of IPC, Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

2. By virtue of order dated 04.08.2025, the benefit of interim anticipatory bail was afforded to the petitioner subject to the condition that he would join the investigation.

3. Today, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with the above-mentioned order, the petitioner has already joined investigation.

4. In response to above-mentioned submissions, it has been submitted by learned State counsel that as per proforma received through official correspondance, the petitioner has joined investigation and that his custody is not required for further investigation.

5. In view of above-mentioned submissions, the order dated 04.08.2025, whereby interim bail has been afforded to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
