1. Prayer in this petition under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.96 dated 20.06.2025 registered at Police Station SGN Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda, under Sections 308(4) & 351(3) of BNS, (later on added Section 61(2) of BNS, 2023 vide DDR No.23 dated 05.07.2025).

2. In compliance of order dated 02.08.2025, short reply by way of an affidavit of Saravjeet Singh Brar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-2 Bathinda, filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.

3. Today, on instructions from ASI Karambir Singh, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 02.08.2025 and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 02.08.2025, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
