JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to release retiral dues along with interest.
2. The petitioner retired on 31.01.2011 and passed away on 01.05.2014. As per affidavit dated 12.12.2024 of respondent No.3, all the retiral dues of the petitioner stand released. Even, a sum of ₹99,125/- was released on 24.04.2024 in favour of his son. The petitioner was also granted pay protection.
3. Mr. Mayank Garg, Advocate submits that there was delay in payment of retiral dues and respondent No.3 did not pay interest. The benefit of pay protection was granted during the pendency of petition, however, consequential benefits have not been paid.

4. Mr. Arvind Seth, Advocate submits that petitioner has already been granted all the retiral dues as well as benefit of pay protection, thus, the instant petition has rendered infructuous.

5. The matter is pending before this Court since 2013. The petitioner passed away on 01.05.2014. The legal representatives of the petitioner were paid all the dues including benefit of pay protection. The last payment of ₹99,125/- was made in 2024.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and keeping in mind that petitioners being legal representatives of deceased employee, despite extension of pay protection, do not want to end the litigation, this Court does not find it appropriate to keep the matter further pending, thus, the petition stands disposed of.
