1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to conduct free and fair investigation in case FIR No.44 dated 22.02.2023 registered under Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and Section 120-B IPC at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, in a time-bound and expeditious manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the matter has been settled between the parties and petition bearing number CRM-M-21633 of 2025 (Sukhjinderjit Singh and others v. State of Punjab and others) for quashing of the aforesaid FIR has also been preferred, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
