This petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is filed seeking quashing of the order dated 30.04.2025 passed in complaint bearing No. NACT/161/2024 dated 08.01.2024, titled as "Mahindra and Mahindra Financial Services Limited Vs. Virender Kumar" vide which the petitioner was declared proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had no intention to evade the legal proceedings and has never deliberately avoided the process of law. He submits that the petitioner was never served with any notice in the aforesaid complaint. A request is made that the petitioner would surrender within a week from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders within a week from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application on the same day and decide it as expeditiously as possible. In case the petitioner fails to surrender within a week, this order shall stand vacated automatically without reference to the Court.
