JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

Mr. Sant Pal Singh Sidhu, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his power of attorney. The same is taken on record.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that till the investigation is pending before the DIG Faridkot who was marked the investigation by this Court, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

The counsel for the State, however, opposes the prayer but concedes that this Court had marked the investigation to the DIG Faridkot.

Keeping in view the above facts, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner till the DIG, Faridkot concludes the investigation. However, if he finds the culpability of the petitioner, then three days

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advance notice shall be given to the petitioner to enable him to avail his remedies in accordance with law.
