Surya Partap Singh, J.

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners for directions to the respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the respondents No.4 to 9.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed a representation dated 01.08.2025 (Annexure P3) before respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Muktsar Sahib. The learned counsel prays for seeking directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the above mentioned representation within a stipulated time.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

3. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a direction for disposing of the representation (Annexure P3) be given to respondent No.2 and the instant writ petition be disposed of.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P3) within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order.
