SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. On joint request of counsel for the parties, main case is taken on Board.

RSA-4630-2013 (O & M)

2. Counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that during the pendency of the instant appeal, dispute has been amicably settled before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and a settlement/compromise dated 27.03.2025 has been arrived at. A specific reference has been made to Para 06 of the settlement, which is reproduced hereunder:-



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“6. That both the parties have settled their dispute on the following terms and conditions:-

a) It has been agreed between the parties that defendant/appellant Corporation i.e. first party would vacate the premises of the second party/respondent within 45 days from today.

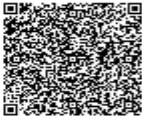
b) It has been further agreed between the parties that the second party/respondent would not be responsible for the pilferage which might have occurred during this litigation period as the property is lying unattended/unguarded since cancellation of license.

c) It has also been agreed between the parties that no encumbrance is put upon the second party/respondent-Devender Singh in a fresh start-up of similar endeavour or something else of other nature in future.

d) It is agreed between the parties that both the parties will request to the Hon'ble High Court to dispose of the present RSA No.4630 of 2013 in terms of the present settlement/agreement.

e) It is further agreed between the parties that both the parties shall withdraw all the Civil/Criminal cases, if any, pending in any Court of Law/Authority in view the present settlement with respect to the present dispute.”

3. In view of the agreement between the parties, appeal and miscellaneous applications are disposed off in terms of settlement dated 27.03.2025 arrived at between the parties.



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4. It is expected that both the parties would adhere to the terms of settlement.
