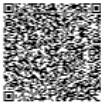

MANISHA BATRA, J.

1. The present appeal has been filed under Section 14-A (2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocity) Act, 1989 (*for short 'the SC/ST Act'*) by the appellant challenging the orders dated 28.07.2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, whereby the applications filed by them under Section 483 of BNSS for grant of regular bail in case arising out of FIR No. 80 dated 05.03.2024, registered under Sections 341, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC and Section 3 of SC/ST Act at Police Station Sohana, had been dismissed.

2. Arguments in this case were heard and order was reserved on 12.08.2025. However, on 20.08.2025, learned counsel for the appellants has appeared and informed this Court that the appellants have since been granted



concession of default bail under Section 167(2) of Cr.P.C. (*which corresponds to Section 187(3) of BNSS*). In view of the same, the present appeal is dismissed being infructuous.
