1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to the respondents to consider his case for premature release in terms of the policy dated 12.04.2002.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 06.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) with regard to his grievances but no action has been taken so far. It is further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to the respondents to decide the aforesaid representation and take necessary action.
