This is a petition under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, for appointment of an independent Arbitrator to adjudicate the disputes and differences which have arisen between the parties out of the agreement with regard to providing and laying SW Pipes, RCC Pipes for sewer lines, construction of MPS, roads, making house connections and construction of 20 MLD STP based on any suitable technology, etc. and all other works contingent thereto as per DNIT at Barnala (under AMRUT Scheme), dated 16.12.2016, Annexure P-1.

2. No reply has been filed on behalf of the respondents, and as stated by learned counsel representing them, they have no objection to the prayer made.

3. Accordingly, petition is allowed. Mr. Justice (Retd.) Rajbir Sehrawat, formerly a Judge of this Court, resident of House No.304, Advocate Society, Sector 49, Chandigarh, Mobile No.7347025005, is



nominated as an Arbitrator to adjudicate the disputes between the parties, subject to compliance of statutory provisions.
