1. Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents to supply copies of the documents signed in original, electronic devices (including Phones) and copy of the Panchnama prepared in relation to cash seized during the search operation conducted on 26.04.2025.
2. Learned counsel for respondents on instructions from Mr. Mihir Narwal, Senior Intelligence Officer, DGCI, Chandigarh Zonal Unit, Chandigarh submits that process of issuing notice to the petitioner is underway and that necessary notice under Section 74 of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 (for short "CGST Act, 2017), shall be issued alongwith copies of relied upon documents and rest of the documents not relied upon shall be returned within a period of two weeks. Insofar as photocopy of Panchnama dated 26.04.2025 in relation to cash seizure is concerned, the same has been handed over to learned counsel for petitioner in Court today itself and cash in question has been handed over to the Income Tax Department. It is thus submitted that this petition is rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to deny the same.
4. Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous, without expression of any opinion on the merits of the matter.
