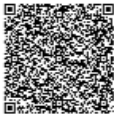

YASHVIR SINGH RATHOR, J. (Oral)

1. The instant petition has been under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.3 for taking action against the accused who openly threatening the petitioners to involve them in some false criminal case.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the representation was given on 31.07.2025 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police. However, it had failed to yield any response. It has been submitted that the official respondents are under a legal obligation to pass an appropriate order on his complaint. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the representation dated 31.07.2025 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.



- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On asking of the Court, Mr. G.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
- 5. In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of and respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioners and take appropriate steps, if any required, under the provisions of law. However, if respondent No.3 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the representation dated 31.07.2025 (Annexure P-1), then the petitioner shall be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the Supreme Court in 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979 ‘*Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors*’.
