For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed. Order dated 07.02.2025 passed by Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, and service book are taken on record as Annexures P-21 and P-22, respectively, subject to all just exceptions.

Main Case

The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a direction to the respondents to sanction second ACP scale with effect from 01.07.2015 to the petitioner, and release all consequential service and retiral benefits, including arrears thereof.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the Directorate has already instructed the concerned District Education Officer to process the petitioner's case for grant of benefits claimed in the instant petition, and decision in this regard will soon be taken whereupon the due benefits as per his entitlement will be released.

3. In view thereof, the petition is disposed of directing the second respondent/Director, Secondary Education, to finally decide the petitioner's

case and release the admissible benefits to him in accordance with law within a period of three months.

4. In case the petitioner remains aggrieved after the decision taken by the second respondent, he will be at liberty to agitate his rights.

5. In case the direction is not complied within the stipulated period, the second respondent shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
