Instant petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to accept the application for registration of gift deed dated 12.03.2025, Annexure P-2, at the appropriate registration fee to be submitted along with the gift deed, when it was presented for registration on 17.03.2025.
2. Mr. Chandail, counsel for the respondents has produced a copy of memo No. DC/SR/2025/863 dated 11.08.2025 and submits that the gift deed has been registered on 08.08.2025 and has been referred to the Collector for determining the proper value and stamp duty payable under Section 47-A of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899.
3. In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of.
4. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to challenge any order passed by the respondents under the Indian Stamp Act, 1899.
