The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case registered against him vide FIR No.164 dated 20.07.2025 under Sections 126(2), 118(1), 115(2), 190, 191(3) of BNS, 2023 (Section 118(2) BNS added later on) at Police Station Kartarpur, Jalandhar Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.08.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 29.08.2025 by way of an affidavit of Vijay Kanwar Paul, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (PBI & Narcotic)-cum-Sub Division Kartarpur, Jalandhar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. The learned State counsel on instructions admits the

aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.08.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands disposed of.
