

**RA-CR-111-2025 in CR-6448-2023**

SARUP SINGH SINCE DECEASED THROUGH LRS VS CENTRAL
GOVERNMENT OF INDIA AND OTHERS

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This is an application preferred under Order 47 Rule 1 read with Section 151 of CPC, seeking review of the order dated 30.07.2025 passed in CR-6448-2023.

Learned counsel for applicant-respondent No.2 has strenuously urged that the land in question stands acquired and that a supplementary award was also passed. It is further submitted that all the other landowners have received compensation, and it is only the applicant/respondent No.2 who has not received the compensation, which is otherwise lying deposited with the competent authority.

I have considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the applicant/respondent No.2.

No error apparent on the face of the record in the order dated 30.07.2025 has been pointed out. It is settled law that no review on merits is maintainable.

That being so, the application is found to be devoid of merit and is accordingly dismissed.
