The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.67 dated 11.04.2024 registered under Sections 363 & 366-A of IPC (Sections 308, 384, 376(2)(n) & 509 of IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act were added later on) at Police Station Odhan, District Dabwali.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 13.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Raj Kaur, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has

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joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.09.2024 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
