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**ROHIT KAPOOR, J. (Oral)**

1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has *inter-alia* prayed for quashing of the impugned show cause notice dated 25.07.2023 (Annexure P-12) and for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to drop the proceedings against the petitioner on the ground that the same are not maintainable in view of the pendency of CWP-27725-2013.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has placed on record the copy of the decision passed in CWP-27725-2013 dated 14.05.2025 in case titled as “**Punjab State Warehousing Corporation Field Employees Union Vs. Union of India and others**”, wherein it has been *inter-alia* directed that any dispute pending consideration on the allegations for which employee faced various charge-sheets/punishment on the issue in

question are to be decided on the basis of the policy/standard operating process dated 22.10.2021 and letter dated 30.05.2022.

3. The attention of the Court has also been drawn to a decision of co-ordinate Bench of this Court passed in CWP-4684-2025, decided on 28.05.2025 titled as “**Shamsher Singh Vs. Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited (PUNSUP) and another**”, whereby the respondents therein were directed to treat the writ petition as a representation and take a decision in terms of the judgment passed in Punjab State Warehousing Corporation Field Employees Union’s case (supra).

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties are *ad-idem* that the present writ petition can be disposed of in terms of the decision passed by this Court in Punjab State Warehousing Corporation Field Employees Union and Shamsher Singh’s cases (supra).

5. In view of the above, the respondents are directed to treat the present writ petition as a representation and to take a decision in terms of the judgment passed in CWP-27725-2013 and other connected petitions as decided on 14.05.2025.

6. The present petition is disposed of in terms of the aforesaid judgments.

7. All pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
