The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 (Commissioner, Karnal Division, District Karnal) to decide the statutory appeal dated 16.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) filed by respondent No.4 (Jaibir Singh) against the order dated 10.10.2024 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.3 (Deputy Commissioner, Karnal).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 (Commissioner, Karnal Division, Karnal) for deciding the statutory appeal dated 16.10.2024 (Annexure P-5), in a time bound manner.
