1. Prayer made is for directing the respondents to regularize the service of the petitioner in terms of the Instructions dated 18.03.2011, with regard to which reliance is placed on the judgment in **Nisha Rani vs. State of Punjab and others**, CWP-28356-2013, decided on 11.10.2023, which has been implemented, vide order dated 27.09.2024, Annexure P-14. Regarding the claim raised in the present petition, a representation dated 26.02.2025, Annexure P-15, has been submitted, but the same has yet not evoked any response. Learned counsel, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same keeping in view the aforesaid judgment, in a time bound manner.

2. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 26.02.2025, taking note of the aforesaid judgment, within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to him and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
