HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

By way of present appeal, challenge has been laid to the judgment and decree dated 10.10.2013 passed by the Court of Additional District Judge, Chandigarh (**hereinafter to be referred as “First Appellate Court”**), whereby an appeal filed against the judgment and decree dated 29.10.2010 passed by the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh (**hereinafter to be referred as “trial Court”**), dismissing the suit for declaration and mandatory injunction, filed at the instance of plaintiff/respondent No. 1-Jatinder Pal Singh, was allowed, thereby setting aside the judgment and decree passed by the trial Court.

[2] Notice of the main appeal stood issued vide order dated 15.01.2014 passed by this Court, which stands listed for hearing on 15.05.2025.

[3] Vide order dated 06.02.2023, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the matter was referred before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

[4] Now, an application bearing **CM No. 4000-C of 2025** has been moved on behalf of the applicant-appellant, seeking disposal of the main appeal in view of the compromise dated 11.03.2024 (Annexure A-1) having been arrived at between the parties as well as for taking up the main appeal today itself.

[5] Notice of the aforesaid application.

[6] Upon advance notice, learned counsel(s) for the respondents accept notice on behalf of respective respondents and admits the factum of the aforesaid compromise having no objection against the prayer made in the aforesaid application.

[7] With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the main appeal is taken up today itself.

[8] In view of the aforesaid development, **CM No. 4000-C of 2025** is **allowed** and the **main appeal** is ordered to be **disposed off** accordingly. The compromise dated 11.03.2024 (Annexure A-1) having been arrived at between the parties be read as part of the order and decree-sheet be prepared accordingly.

[9] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
