1. The instant petition has been filed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for willfully disobeying the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 19.05.2025 (Annexure P-3), passed in CRWP-5109-2025, whereby the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar-respondent was directed to look into the representation dated 02.07.2024 regarding threat perception and take necessary steps, if any required.

2. Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent submits that order dated 19.05.2025 stands complied with as speaking order dated 28.07.2025 has been passed by the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. A copy of the said order has been circulated in the Court, which is taken on record.

3. Since learned counsel for the petitioners is appearing through Video Conferencing, one copy of the aforesaid order be sent to



the petitioner through e-mail, upon furnishing e-mail address to the office of the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.

- 5. Rule stands discharged.
- 6. However, liberty be granted to the petitioners to avail appropriate remedy, in case, any grievance is still left.
- 7. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
