The petitioners through instant petition are seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to provide police protection to them and protect their life and liberty from respondents No.4 to 7 and further issue direction to respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in the life and liberty as granted by Article 21 of the Constitution of India. They are further seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 not to register any criminal case against the petitioners and family members of petitioners No.1 and 2 arising out of their relationship and further directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to take action on the representation dated 02.08.2025 (Annexure P-3).

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Gorav Kathuria, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures that jurisdictional authorities would look into the representation dated



02.08.2025 (Annexure P-3).

4. This Court in view of the statement of learned State counsel is sanguine of the fact that competent authority would look into the matter and redress grievance of the petitioners. No further order is warranted.
