2. Learned State counsel, who has an advance notice, submits that the police has already forwarded the cancellation report in the present case and the same is pending before the Court concerned.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would not pursue the present case if he is given liberty to contest the cancellation report in the Court at Nakodar.

4. Allowed.

5. The quashing petition thus stands disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
