1. The only grievance which has been raised by the petitioner through the instant writ petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is that the respondent No.2-Punjab School Education Board, has not taken final decision on its representation dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure P-10).

2. The lackadaisical and indolent approach of the respondent No.2, propelled the petitioner to file the instant writ petition, seeking *mandamus*, upon the respondent No.2, to take a final decision on the representation (*supra*).

3. Notice of motion.

4. Dr. Dharminder Singh Lamba, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3, and waives service.

5. Learned counsel for the State submits that he does not have any objection, in case, a *mandamus*, is passed upon the respondent No.2-Punjab School Education Board, to decide the representation (supra), in a time bound manner.

In view of the above submission made by the learned counsel for the State, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**, with a *mandamus*, upon the respondent No.2-Chairman, Punjab School Education Board, to take a final decision on the representation dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure P-10), within a period of one month, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
