Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (For short “BNSS”), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.372 dated 21.06.2024 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1).

2. On 07.08.2025, following order had been passed: -

“ By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS, 2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was granted concession of interim bail vide order dated 27.02.2025 by the learned Trial Court and was directed to join the investigation by 03.03.2025 but owing to his medical condition the petitioner could not join the investigation by 03.03.2025.



Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, Sr. DAG Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and prays for time to file the status report/reply in the matter. Mr. Vikas Malik, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his memo of appearance. The same is taken on record. Learned counsel for the complainant and learned State counsel has opposed the medical certificate by submitting that there is no mobile number mentioned on the medical certificate. However, taking a lenient view, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation on 14.08.2025 at 11.00 A.M. P.S. Surajkund, District Faridabad and would appear as and when required by the Investigating Officer and co-operate with the investigating agency. In the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 of BNSS.

Adjourned to 15.09.2025.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 07.08.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 07.08.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
