The present criminal writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect her life and liberty from the private respondent No.4.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to decide the representation dated 28.07.2025 (Annexures P-3) moved by the petitioner and take necessary action.

Notice of motion to official respondents only.

Mr. Jatinder Pal Singh, Sr. DAG Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the needful shall be done in due course.

Keeping in view the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the

present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to decide the aforesaid representation dated 28.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner within a period of two months from today by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and take necessary action, if so required.

However, if, respondent No.2 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the representation (Annexure P-3), the petitioner shall be informed as per mandate of law.
