HARPREET SINGH BRAR J. (Oral)

1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of GD No. 50 dated 29.04.2019 under Sections 341, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.100 dated 28.04.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 15.04.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 10.02.2025:

“On request, adjourned to 11.03.2025.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate within a period of one week from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, to get their statements recorded regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the next date of hearing.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate through fax for compliance.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of other connected case.”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466** and **Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63** and Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this petition is allowed and GD No. 50 dated 29.04.2019 under Sections 341, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.100 dated 28.04.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed, qua the petitioners.
