SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in a case arising out of FIR No.91 dated 06.07.2025 under Sections 21(c) and 29 of NDPS Act (GD No.37 dated 08.07.2025 added lateron), Police Station Vairoke, District Fazilka.
2. Vide order dated 07.08.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.
3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with order dated 07.08.2025, the petitioner has already joined investigation.
4. In view of above mentioned contention, on the instructions of ASI



Mukhtiar Singh, Police Station Vairoke, who is present in Court, learned State Counsel has stated that in compliance with the order dated 07.08.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He has further stated that the presence of petitioner is not required for the investigation of the present case.

5. In view of the above mentioned stand of learned State counsel and the fact that no contraband was recovered from the possession of petitioner and he has been simply nominated by his co-accused, the order dated 07.08.2025 granting interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute.

Present petition stand allowed, accordingly.
