The present second petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS of 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 12 dated 17.01.2021, under Sections 307, 458, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC 1860, (Section 307 IPC has been deleted later on) registered at Police Station Tripri Patiala, District Patiala (Annexure P-1).

The present petition seeking anticipatory bail was not maintainable before this Bench in light of the order dated 21.05.2025 passed in CRM-M-27860-2025, Sunny Kumar Vs. State of Punjab, vide which he was directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days, who choose to file the anticipatory bail before the trial Court below and it was a wrong forum adopted by the petitioner.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the instant petition.

Prayer is accepted.

The present petition is dismissed as having been withdrawn with liberty to surrender again before the trial Court and seek regular bail by moving necessary application, if so advised, within a period of 07 days from today. Penalty of Rs.20,000/- ordered as per the order dated 21.05.2025 has been deposited and receipt of the same has been annexed with the petition as Annexure P-4. This receipt shall be produced before the trial Court.
