Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 to 7 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.8 to 13 and further for deciding the representation dated 03.08.2025 (Annexure P4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner is having threat at the hands of private respondents No.8 to 13. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has already moved a representation dated 03.08.2025(Annexure P-4) before respondents No.2 to 5, but no action on the same has been taken till date. He submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.5 is directed to look into and decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that she has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated

03.08.2025 (Annexure P-4) is looked into.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, to look into the aforesaid representation and to take appropriate action as per law, if any required, at the earliest.
