SUBHAS MEHLA, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondent No.2 to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8 and to decide her representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-4).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a civil dispute between the parties and petitioner is harassed by her son and daughter-in-law i.e. respondents No.7 & 8. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that he would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 i.e. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to decide or take necessary action on the aforesaid representation



filed by the petitioner raising her grievances, which has not been considered and no action has been taken till now.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. Mr. Ravinder Singh, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner will be looked into and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law, at the earliest.
- 5. In view of the above and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner in accordance with law.
