1. Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to pass an appropriate order on the enquiry report dated 10.11.2022 (Annexure P-2) conducted by the SDM, Anandpur Sahib and to decide the representation dated 18.03.2023 (Annexure P-3), as preferred by the petitioner.

2. In compliance of the previous order, reply dated 25.02.2025 has been filed by the State, by way of affidavit of Mr. Rajwinder Singh, Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar, today in the Court, which is taken on record. Along with reply, Annexure R-4/1 has been appended, which reflects that a decision dated 23.01.2025, has already been taken on the representation of the petitioner.

3. Since, decision has already been taken on the representation made by the petitioner, therefore, no further order is required to be passed by this Court.

4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner requested to withdraw the present petition.

5. Accordingly, the present petition stands **dismissed as withdrawn**. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to challenge the above mentioned speaking order, in case, petitioner has any grievance left, by taking an appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
