The matter has again been discussed with the learned counsel for the parties in detail and they have arrived at a settlement.

As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.4,70,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. As per statement, the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1- Rabina widow of Jakariya, for & on behalf of all the appellants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a cheque in the sum of Rs. Rs.4,70,000/- favoring appellant No.1-Rabina widow of Jakariya, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellants.

Pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of.
