SHALINI SINGH NAGPAL J.

1. Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.35 dated 26.05.2025, under Sections 316(2), 85 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Police Station Women Cell Ludhiana, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana. This is the first petition for anticipatory bail.

2. Vide order dated 11.08.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Investigating Officer ASI Surinder Kumar, has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation on 14.08.2025, co-operated and is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. Considering all relevant facts and circumstances, but without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 11.08.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.
