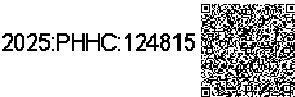

1. Through the instant writ petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, challenge is thrown to the orders/communications dated 20.11.2020 (Annexure P-2), and 21.09.2023, whereby, the Review Committee has declined to permit the petitioner to revise her thesis. A Mandamus is also prayed for, to direct respondent No.2, to consider and decide her representation 27.01.2025 (P-6).

2. Mr. Rishav Jain, Advocate, causes appearance on behalf of the respondent-University on advance copy, and submits that the competent authority has contemplated to reconsider the claim of the petitioner. Accordingly, the representation (supra), will be considered and decided, in accordance with law.

3. Neither the petitioner, nor anyone on her behalf is present to pursue the matter.



4. In view of the above, the instant writ petition is disposed of, with a Mandamus upon the respondent-University to consider and decide the representation (supra), within three weeks from the date of passing of the order, and communicate the decision so taken, to the petitioner.
