The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.6 and 7 not to discharge the dirty water in the open/on the road with further direction to the said respondents to discharge the dirty water of the village in the sewerage already installed in the village.
